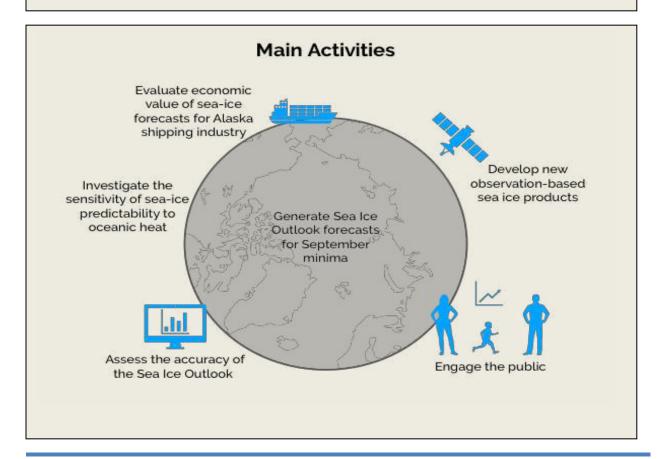
The Sea Ice Prediction Network—Phase 2 (SIPN2)

will take place between 2018-2022. SIPN2 will improve Arctic sea ice forecasts using a multi-disciplinary approach that includes modeling, new products, data analysis, and scientific networks. Stakeholder engagement and partnerships are fostered through the open Sea Ice Outlook (SIO) process, action teams, webinars, and workshops. SIPN2 builds on the success of the Sea Ice Prediction Network efforts during 2014-2017.
